

SERIES CODES / SERIAL NUMBERS

US patent applications consist of a 2-digit series code and a 6-digit application serial that is assigned chronologically as they are received at the USPTO. Series codes assigned to applications generally correspond to a range of years in which the application was filed at the USPTO.
